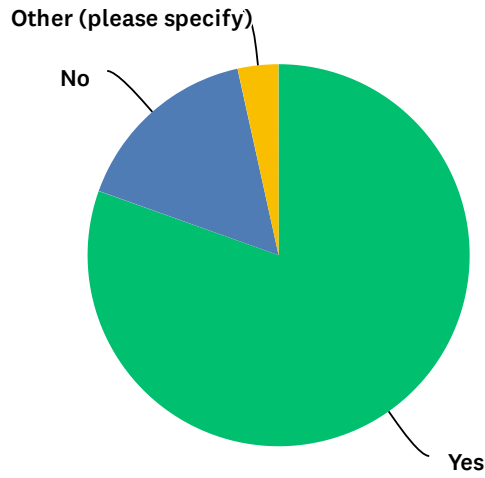


Q1 Are you in favor of replacing one tennis court at Oshtemo Township Park with two permanent pickleball courts?

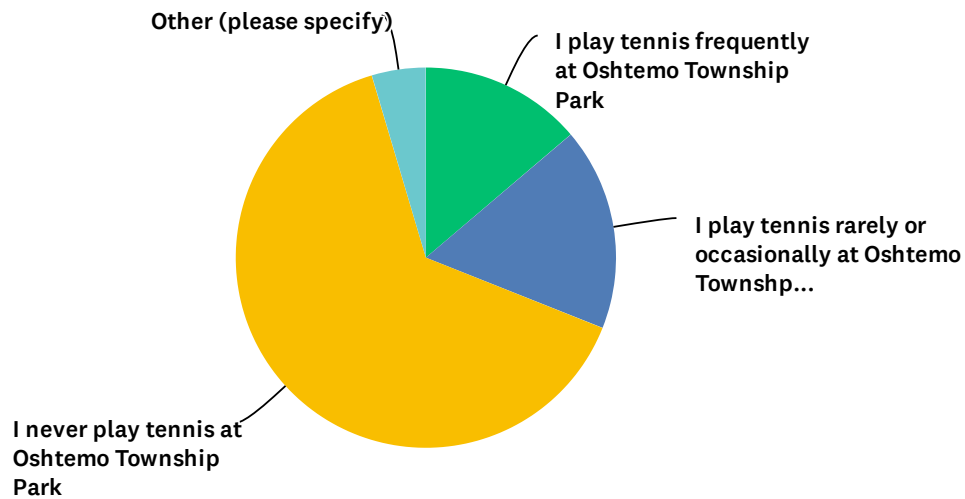

Q2 How often do you play tennis at Oshtemo Township Park?

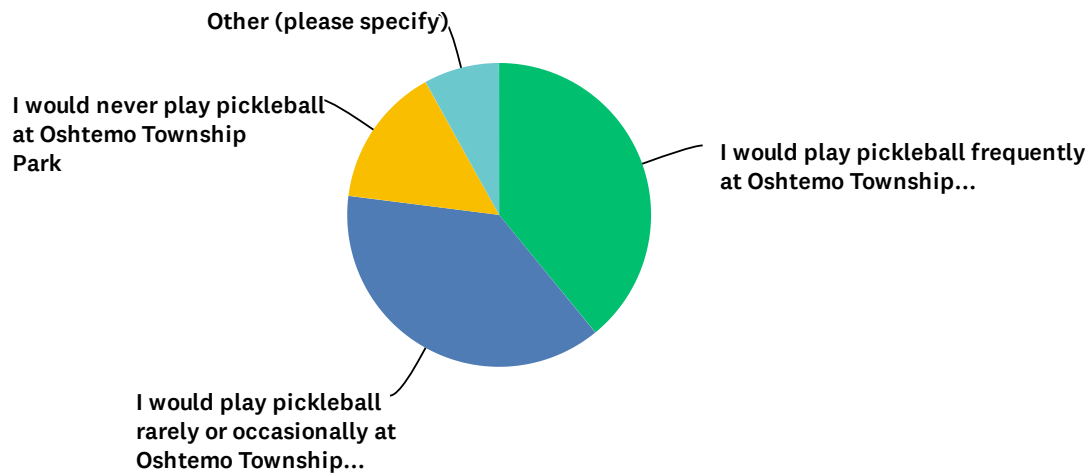

Q3 How often would you play pickleball at Oshtemo Township Park?

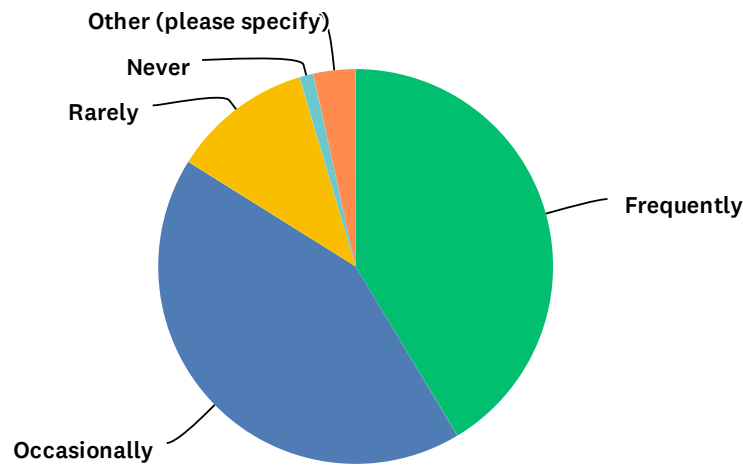

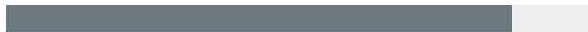

Karen, I love the idea of converting one of the two tennis courts to pickleball. I am an Oshtemo resident and have been to the park many times over the years with my wife, children, and now grandchildren. During all of my visits I have never seen either of the tennis courts being used to play tennis. I played pickleball on one of the courts once as a last resort when all other courts in the area were full. If you make the conversion, those two courts will see more use than any other facility in the park. You would do well to plan on an additional 10 courts to be constructed as soon as possible.

My wife and I are avid pickleball players and have been for years. I am sure you are aware of the exploding popularity of pickleball. We love the game and are finding it harder and harder to find open courts. We played yesterday at Frays park and had to cut our playtime short due to overwhelming demand for the two courts there. The one remaining tennis court was not used for tennis but for pickleball warmup and practice while people waited to play. We play at Parchment (4 courts) 6th street (8 courts) and Frays (2 courts). There are times when all the courts mentioned are completely full.

Happy to know you are considering adding needed courts. Many more are needed to keep up with the exciting growth of the sport.
